### ALL PURPOSE STAIN AND GRAFFITI-REMOVER

## **FEATURES AND USE**

MURALES contains organic solvents that allow to remove graffiti and different types of stains. It removes oily stains, dirt or writing in paint from natural stone, concrete, brick, plaster, metal and architectonic structures. MURALES does not contain chloride solvents that damage the ozone layer. It is effective and active on paints normally used for graffiti. Has a pleasant scent. As a stain-remover, it removes wine, beverage, coffee, grease stains, and felt-tip pen marks, from cotto surfaces, polished or rough stone, and vitrified porcelain stoneware. Thanks to its viscosity it adheres to the paint/stain. It is not volatile and can therefore act for longer periods on the most stubborn stains and graffiti. It can be rinsed with water with high pressure machine.

## METHOD OF USE and DILUTION



MURALES is ready to use. Resa: 1L / 4-6mg

Remove stains, splashes, graffiti: before using the product, carry out preliminary tests to check the compatibility on paints or plastics. Apply the product on the surfaces to be cleaned using a brush or fleece and let act for a few minutes, or in case of stubborn stains, for 1-2 hours. Remove the product using a hard brush, abrasive pad or high-pressure washer and rinse with water. Repeat the operation if necessary. Remove grease, coffee, wine, beverages, etc. from cotto tiles, natural stone, marble, granite, travertine, agglomerate and porcelain stoneware floors: apply the product on the stain and let act for the required time (from a few minutes to 1-2 hours). Wipe off the residues using a sponge and rinse thoroughly with water (preferably hot).
